Just a few reminders in case you missed (or slept through) orientation!

*If you have not already done so, please make sure you turn in all of your paperwork as soon as possible. This information is important and necessary to insure the safety of your child. If you have a doctor's visit scheduled soon you may bring the medical form once it has been completed by the doctor. We will need the medical form and immunization records by the end of the month.

Orientation Notes

*Tuition is due by the **7th** of each month. All late payments will be assessed a \$10 late fee. **PLEASE NO CASH**. Please drop all payments into the tuition box located on the wall near the preschool entrance.

*Make sure your children are dressed to play and get dirty and are wearing closed-toe shoes. Please no flip-flops!

*Please make sure your child has a Ziploc bag with extra clothes in it including socks and underwear. These will be kept in your child's cubbie to use as needed. *Bring a daily snack and lunch. We encourage healthy snacks such as fruit and crackers. We strongly discourge snacks such as chips, candy bars, cookies and snack cakes. Please be aware that we do not heat or cool food.



*We encourage parents to use our playground after school to fellowship with other parents, however, all children need to be properly supervised and reminded to follow the playground rules. If you are planning to stay after school, please take your child to the bathroom as soon as you pick up as the doors will be locked so we may begin cleaning.

*When dropping off, we recommend



that you do not "sneak out" of the room when your child is not looking. Although it may take a couple of weeks, our teachers are very aware of separation anxiety and are usually able to help your child adjust to being away from their parents. We encourage you to be brief, tell your child you love them, give them a kiss and let them know that you will be back to pick them up after lunch.



*Our doors will open at 8:25 and

school begins at 8:30. The teachers have many fun things for the kids to do in the mornings with their classes so please be prompt in getting them to school so they don't miss out!

*Please sign your child in and out when dropping off and picking up.

School is over at 12:30 and we ask that you are prompt in picking up as well. If you are running late, please call the office to let us know that you are on the way so your child will not worry.

*If you need to drop off late or pick up early, please use the front entrance and check in as a visitor. For safety reasons we keep all doors locked during the school day.
