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

\*Tuition is due by the **7th** of each month. All late payments will be assessed a \$10 late fee. **PLEASE NO CASH**. Please drop all payments into the tuition box located on the wall near the preschool entrance.

\*Doors will open at 8:25 each morning and school begins at 8:30. The teachers are busy getting ready for the day.

\*If you need to drop off late or pick up early, please use the front entrance and check in as a visitor. For safety reasons we keep all doors locked during the school day.

\*Sick policies: Please make sure your child is free of fever, diarrhea or vomiting for at least 24 hours before returning to preschool.

\*We encourage parents to use our playground after school to fellowship with other parents, however, all children need to be properly supervised and reminded to follow the playground rules. If you are planning to stay after school, please take your child to the bathroom as soon as you pick up as the doors will be locked so we may begin cleaning.

\*We love parent volunteers here at A.P.P.L.E.Seeds Preschool! There are many opportunities for you to volunteer such as making play dough, reading to your child's class or helping out during special events such as Field Day. Or, if you have a special talent or a really cool job that you would like to share with the children, please let us know.
