Important Reminders

- **Paperwork** - If you have not already turned in all of the required paperwork, please do so immediately! We have quite a few outstanding medical reports and immunization records.
- **Tuition** is due on the 7th. All tuition received after the 7th MUST include a \$10 late fee.
- **Change of clothes.** As the weather continues to get colder, please remember to bring a warmer set of extra clothes.
- **Sign in / Sign out** - It is very important that you are signing your child in and out daily.
